FOR YOUR INFORMATION!

I am including this information to help settle the misconception I've been hearing about our societies and their relationship to the Valley of Cleveland.

- The By-laws state that we are to show allegiance to the Valley of Cleveland and what the parameters for membership are.
- Article one-Section Two: The Society hereby acknowledges allegiance and shall at all times be subject to the bylaws, rules and regulations of the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite of the Valley of Cleveland, Ohio.

Brethren, this means any Scottish Rite member can belong socially to any society. However, only members of that society of the Valley of Cleveland may be officers in that society. **Please also read Article II, Section 1.**

I am writing about this because there have been occasions where a brother from a different valley becomes active in a society of the Valley of Cleveland and wants to become an officer. It is not necessary that the President of that society let the brother know that he cannot serve as an officer.

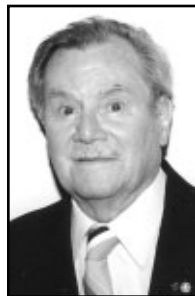

of the East and West, whose successors in later days were the Hapsburgs and the Romanoffs.

Thus, the eagle of the Eastern Empire, united with that of the West, typified the Holy Roman Empire when ancient Byzantine, or Constantinople, shared with the city of Rome the honor of being the capitol of that Empire.

The symbol of the double-headed eagle was first known to Freemasonry in 1758, upon the establishment of a body calling itself Emperors of the East and West, whose successors today are the Supreme Councils of the Thirty-Third Degree that have inherited the insignia of the Rite of Perfection, a rite of Twenty-five degrees, from which was evolved a large part of the present system of the Scottish Rite.

The sixteenth Article of the Constitutions of 1786 defines the eagle on the Grand Seal of the Supreme Council as a large black eagle, with two heads, the beak of gold, the wings displayed, grasping a naked sword in its talons, etc.

There is another double-headed eagle, formerly referred to, in the Ritual of the 32nd degree. This emblem is on a field of green and in the Camp represents the standard about which the Prussian knights and those of Libanus gathered. **C.N.B.**
