
TWO DEGREES PRESENTED AT OUR FEBRUARY MEETING: NEW MEMBERS WELCOME TO JOIN

LODGE OF PERFECTION 4º - 14º

4° The Builder - As we face challenges in our daily lives and discover that our Grand Master Hiram Abif was called upon to face an insurmountable task: to create a home for God on earth. In the 4th degree, Hiram joins with his brothers in reverence to God to build a physical, spiritual, and moral temple, the Holy of Holies.

8° Intendant of the Building - In the 8th Degree, we dramatize how Solomon ascended to the throne of all Israel and Judah. In the lessons of the Eighth Degree, we learn by Solomon's example that each new honor is a step toward moral perfection and that each honor earned demands attention to a particular duty. We should strive for perfection by using the great principles of "God's inherent love, charity, morality and kindness." Labor is honorable if done with sobriety, temperance, punctuality, and industry. The 8th degree portrays important lessons that are more applicable now than ever and Theodore Breck Lodge #714 is proud to confer this degree for the members of the Valley of Cleveland.



JOURNEY TO OUR NEW HOME



VALLEY OF CLEVELAND SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUINITIES

The Valley of Cleveland Scholarship Committee is pleased to offer three scholarship program opportunities to the members of our Valley. The requirements and applications for each of those scholarships are listed below. The deadline to apply for these scholarships is **April 1, 2021**. All applications can be sent to the Valley of Cleveland Office or emailed to the Valley Secretary at the address listed on each application form.

The Ross and Joyce Black Scholarship was established to provide college or trade school scholarships to graduating High School Seniors whose father, step-father, grandfather or step-grandfather are members of the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite, Valley of Cleveland, or who are a member of DeMolay, Rainbow or Jobs Daughters. It is non -renewable.

The Leon M. Abbott Scholarship is administered through the Supreme Council of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction. It provides financial support for the continuing undergraduate and graduate education of Scottish Rite Masons, young men and women from Scottish Rite families, and Masonic-related youth groups. The Donald R. James Medical Scholarship provides scholarships to students who are pursuing a career in medicine, dentistry, or sports medicine, and who meet the specific criteria of the scholarship. It may be applied to *tuition only* and cannot exceed fifty percent of the amount of tuition. It cannot be used for books, room & board or other incidental expenses. It is a renewable scholarship.
