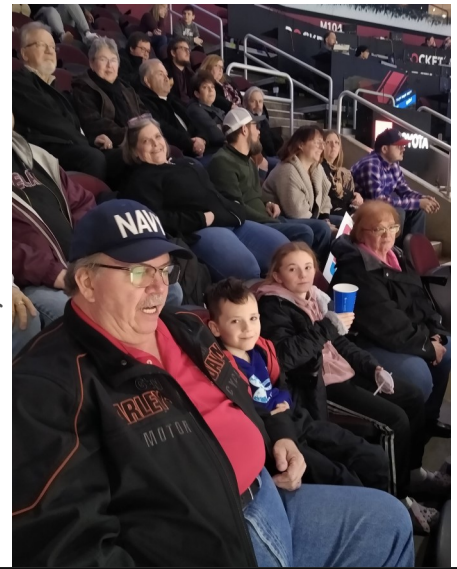
A NIGHT WITH THE MONSTERS
